CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Junior Kids: Bible Truth: God wants friends to help each other

Bible Story: The Good Samaritan

Bible Verse: "Give to the one who asks you for something." Matthew 5:42 **Godprint: Friendliness** develops when children begin building relationships with others that reflect God's loving relationship with them.

Grade 1-4: We will focus on the virtue of "Fairness" which is making sure that everyone is treated equally. **Bible Story:** the story of Saul's conversion (Acts 9) and how he realized that he needed to accept everyone. **Bible Verse:** "God treats everyone the same . . . He accepts people from every nation. He accepts all who have respect for him and do what is right." Acts 10: 34-35. **Bottom Line:** Show God's love to everyone, including your enemies.

56 Degrees: Bible Blitz Month: Our focus in God's Big Story is on the New Testament books of 1 & 2 Thessalonians, and 1 & 2 Timothy. As we piece together the parts of the big story, we are discovering how this is God's story of his plan and his love for each of us.
