**Junior Kids:** Bible Truth: God wants friends to help each other

**Bible Story:** The Good Samaritan

**Bible Verse:** "Give to the one who asks you for something." Matthew 5:42 **Godprint: Friendliness** develops when children begin building relationships with others that reflect God's loving relationship with them.

**Grade 1-4:** This morning we continue our focus on the virtue of "Fairness", which is making sure that everyone is treated equally. The Bible story is the parable of the Good Samaritan, from Luke 10:25-37. Our Bible verse is "God treats everyone the same . . . He accepts people from every nation.
