CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Junior Kids: Bible Blitz Month: Our focus in God's Big Story is on the New Testament books of 1 & 2 Peter, and 1, 2, & 3 John. As we piece together the parts of the big story, we are discovering how this is God's story of His plan and His love for each of us.

Grade 1-4: This morning we continue our focus on the virtue of "Fairness", which is making sure that everyone is treated equally. The Bible story is from Matthew 28, where Jesus gives his disciples instructions before he goes to heaven. Our Bible verse is "God treats everyone the same . . . He accepts people from every nation. He accepts all who have respect for him and do what is right." Acts 10: 34-35
The Bottom Line: Jesus wants everyone you meet to know him.
