Junior Kids: Bible Truth: God wants friends to help each other

Bible Story: The Good Samaritan

Bible Verse: "Give to the one who asks you for something." Matthew 5:42 **Godprint: Friendliness** develops when children begin building relationships with others that reflect God's loving relationship with them.

Grade 1-4: We begin our focus on the virtue of "Fairness" which is treating everyone equally. The **Bible focus** from James 2, teaches us that it is important to treat everyone the same. Our **Bible verse** is "God treats everyone the same . . . He accepts people from every nation. He accepts all who have respect for him and do what is right." Acts 10: 34-35

The **Bottom Line:** Everyone is important to God, so be careful how you treat them.
