## CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

**Junior Kids:** Bible Truth: God helps us obey Him **Bible Story:** Jonah  
**Bible Verse:** "Do what is right and good in the Lord's eyes." Deut 6:18  
**Godprint: Submissiveness:** Preschoolers learning to make choices can learn that obeying God is the most important choice of all.

**Grade 1-4:** This morning we conclude our focus on the virtue of "Hope" which is believing that something good can come out of something bad. The Bible story, from Luke 22:7-30, tells of the last supper that Jesus ate with his disciples before he died. Our Bible verse is "We know that in all things, God works for the good of those who love him." Romans 8:28. The Bottom Line: Jesus had to die so you could live forever.

**56 Degrees:** This month we will *grapple* with some common questions related to things and activities that seem to be a lot of fun. We'll consider what the Bible has to say about today's question: "Is God a party pooper?"
