## CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

### Junior Kids – April 2010

**Bible Truth:** Jesus died and rose again

**Bible Story:** Easter

**Bible Verse:** "Always be joyful because you belong to the Lord. I will say it again. Be joyful." Philippians 4:4

**Godprint: Joy:** Easter is a time for young children to learn a faith pattern of expressing joy in Jesus.

**Grade 1-4:** We are discovering the virtue of **Conviction**, which is "standing up for what is right even when others don't." Our Bible story is from Luke 22:54-62, where we saw Peter denying his friend Jesus, and then experiencing Jesus' complete forgiveness. Peter discovered that **when you stand up for what is right, you may have to stand alone.** This month's Bible verse is "Brothers and sisters, don't ever get tired of doing the right thing." 2 Thess 3:13

**56 Degrees:** Today's focus is on Missions, and discovering how we can be an influence for God's kingdom on people who don't know Jesus.
