**Bible Truth:** Jesus died and rose again

**Bible Story:** Easter

**Bible Verse:** *"Always be joyful because you belong to the Lord. I will say it again. Be joyful."* Philippians 4:4

Godprint: **Joy:** Easter is a time for young children to learn a faith pattern of expressing joy in Jesus.

**Grade 1-4:** This morning we continue our focus on the virtue of **Conviction**, which is "standing for what is right even when others don't." **Bible Story:** Acts 6 & 7.
