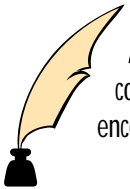

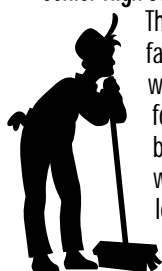
**Junior Kids:** Bible Truth: God wants us to help do his work.
