I. DISCOVER THE _____

"So I tried to understand why the wicked prosper. But what a difficult task it is! Then I went into your sanctuary, O God, and I finally understood the destiny of the wicked." Ps. 73:16-17

Common Mistakes

We listen to

"... they followed the advice of the pilot..." (vs 11)

We follow

"most of the crew wanted to go on..." (vs 12)

We rely on

"When a light wind began blowing from the south, the sailors thought they could make it..." (vs 13)

II. DETERMINE

"For our present troubles are small and won't last very long. Yet they produce for us a glory that vastly outweighs them and will last forever!" 2 Cor. 4:17

"We can rejoice, too, when we run into problems and trials, for we know that they help us develop endurance. And endurance develops strength of character, and character strengthens our confident hope of salvation." Rom. 5:3-4

III. WORK OUT YOUR

"Don't count on your warhorse to give you victory - for all its strength, it cannot save you. But the LORD watches over those who fear him, those who rely on his un failing love. He rescues them from death and keeps them alive in times of famine. We put our hope in the LORD. He is our help and our shield. In him our hearts rejoice, for we trust in his holy name.
