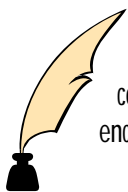

Text: Romans 4:17-25

I. REMEMBER WHAT GOD _____

"This happened because Abraham believed in the God who brings the dead back to life and who creates new things out of nothing." (vs. 17)

*"What is impossible with men is possible with God."
Luke 18:27*

II. RELY ON WHAT GOD _____

"Even when there was no reason for hope, Abraham kept hoping—believing that he would become the father of many nations"(vs. 18)

*"While God was testing him, Abraham still trusted in God and his promises, so he offered his son Isaac..."
Heb. 11:17*

III. FACE THE FACTS _____

*"Without weakening in his faith, he faced the fact that his body was as good as dead... and Sarah's womb was also dead. Yet he didn't waver with unbelief..."
(vs. 19-20a)*
