### FRUIT THAT IS NEVER OUT OF SEASON - PEACE

*"But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things!" Galatians 5:22-23*

#### Misconceptions about peacemaking:

#### Three experiences of peace for the believer:

2. Peace of God - an \_\_\_\_\_ experience.

*"And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them." Romans 8:28*

3. Peace on earth - a \_\_\_\_\_ experience.

#### Three steps for you to consider:

3. Focus on the \_\_\_\_\_ of others.

*"Don't look out only for your own interests, but take an interest in others, too." Philippians 2:4*
