## **STUDENT MISSION TRIP**

**June 27 – 29:** The team leaves Eastview Church to spend two days and two nights camping. The campsite has no running water, no electricity and no outhouse facilities. It pours rain while we set up our campsite. The rain continues well into Saturday afternoon. Our time is spent praying together as a team and preparing for the week of ministry that is coming. Our campsite is strategically located in the midst of what was once a residential school.

**June 29 – July 4:** On Sunday, we leave our campsite and drive the four hours to Altona. We have a hot meal when we arrive at Seeds Church, enjoy a time of worship and preparation for the activities the next day. Every day begins with an early morning prayer session before we head off to the Roseau River First Nations Community. When we arrive there, we spend time leading a sports camp in the school and a kids camp in the community center. Evenings are spent with worship, attending sessions, and telling one another our “God Moments” for the day.

**July 5 -6:** Debrief! The team unwinds and tries to unpack what has happened throughout the past 8 days. We go water rafting down the Roseau River and talk about how to make the trip stick once we get home. Sunday morning is spent at South Park MB Church leading the worship service and hanging out afterwards for a pot luck lunch before hitting the road to come back home. What an adventure!
