## CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

**Junior Kids:** Bible Truth: God hears our prayers

Bible Story: Samuel Talks to God

Bible Verse: *"The Lord will hear me when I call out to him."* Psalm 4:3

Godprint: **Prayerfulness:** Preschoolers will discover that because we are mindful of the presence of God, we can call on Him and He will hear us.

**Grade 1-4:** Today we continue our focus on **Determination**, which is deciding it's worth it to finish what you started.
