CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Junior Kids: Bible Truth: God is the greatest

Bible Story: David and Goliath

Bible Verse: *"My God will meet all your needs."* Philippians 4:19

Godprint: **Trust:** Trust is essential to all good relationships. Preschoolers learn that we can rely on God completely because God is trustworthy.

Grade 1-4: This is our final lesson on the virtue of **Determination**, which is deciding it's worth it to finish what you started. In **Today's story** (Num 14:1-39) we learned how the Israelites missed out on a great thing when they gave up trusting in God to protect them. The result: 40 years spent wandering in the wilderness. Our **scripture verse:** *"Let us keep on running the race marked out for us."* Heb 12:1. **Bottom Line** — Keep doing what you should do so you don't miss out on something really good.
