### A note from Winnipeg Remand Centre

*On behalf of the Winnipeg Remand Centre (WRC), chaplain Ceas and I would like to send along this well deserved note of appreciation and thanks. This is for the ongoing life giving work and ministry of those volunteers from Eastview Church (remembering especially Chaplain Greg Armstrong, and the Hamm family).*

*During the last reporting year, these diverse groups and individuals, under the unifying banner of the Christian Gospel have ministered to those in custody at the WRC. Some of the people they minister to have fallen between the cracks, others were born there. But all are in need of the Christian message of hope, forgiveness and redemption.*

*As full time staff chaplains at the WRC we can attest to the fact that week after week, inmates look forward to the visits, Bible studies and Sunday worship provided by these outside volunteers. I have heard it said that for some, it is the high point of their week. This appreciation extends from other staff and Correctional Officers as well.*

*Sometimes what is most important is most difficult to see. This is often true in delivering the Christian message to the margins of society. This ministry is not for everyone, it is difficult and at times frustrating, especially when working with a large institution, but it is so very, important.*

*The need here is great; these volunteers make a real difference to the lives of those they reach. Not only on the day of the visit, but throughout the week after. We simply could not manage without the passionate and joyful assistance of such volunteers.*

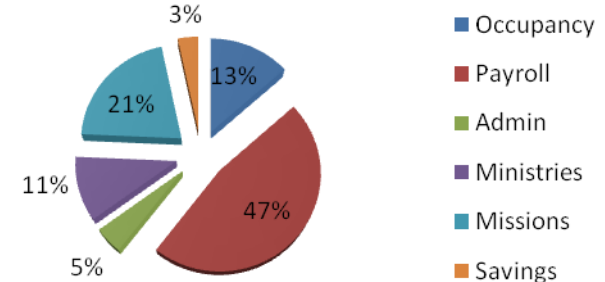
