*Rueben, currently the worship pastor at Hillsong Church in London, with some collaborators (re)wrote this powerful song that has won its way into the hearts of Eastview. When asked in an interview about the writing of this song, he shared a story of a visit to Hillsong Church in Stockholm. Shortly before this visit, Scandinavia experienced a major tragedy involving a man with a gun, opening fire and killing many children and adults. As Rueben sat down with some worship leaders in Sweden, "...The lyrics, 'My hope is built on nothing less, than Jesus' blood and righteousness' felt like the right thing for now and for us." So out of this old hymn and their current tragedy birthed this song. They asked themselves, when the days seem darkest, what hope is there for us?*
