Dear Brothers and Sisters at Eastview,

We are grateful for each of you that attended our Annual Fall Congregational meeting on November 3rd. For those of you that were unable to attend, here are the details of some important decisions that we made together:

- Affirmation of Wilhelmine Kagazo for Missions Committee - Affirmed
- Affirmation of Winston Churchill as Leadership Board Moderator - Affirmed
- Affirmation of the Leadership Board recommendation for the sale of 188 Princess Street, as presented - Declined

Total ballots received: 129 Affirmed: 74 (57.4%) Declined: 45 (34.9%) Abstained: 10 (7.7%)

As per our constitution bylaws for affirmation percentages required, the affirmation of the Leadership Board recommendation for the sale of 188 Princess was declined. We have had several meetings since November 3 and continue to be committed to honouring God which includes honouring financial stewardship as we move forward together in serving the least of these. As we briefly addressed in the recommendation, the One88 Lead Team has requested to move forward to become a formal church plant.

The Leadership Board is assembling a committee that will lead this evaluation and discernment process. We invite each of you to join in with the Leadership Board, Property & Finance, and the One88 Lead Team on Sunday November 26th at 6:30pm at Eastview. We will be petitioning God through worship, prayer, and fasting for wisdom and discernment in the decisions that need to be made.

We have also created a new email address: Moderator@eastview.org. This address can be used to personally address the Leadership Board with concerns you may have, words of encouragement, or questions you would like addressed. All attempts will be made to respond to emails within 48 hours.

In closing, as Apostle Paul reminds us in Ephesians 6, our battle is not against flesh and blood but against principalities and powers. The spiritual forces of evil are active against God building His kingdom but they will not prevail. God builds His church and the gates of hell will not overcome it. We thank you for lifting us up in your prayers, your wise words of exhortation, and your loving encouragement. It is an honour and privilege to live a life of service with each one of you.


