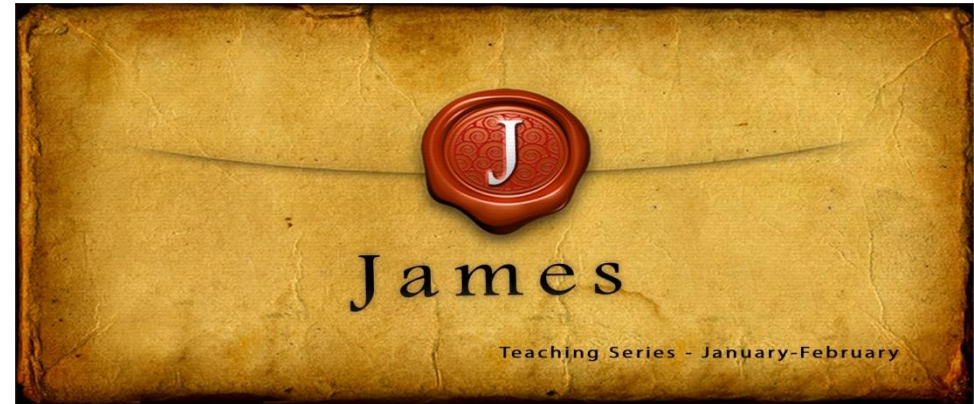

Fusion [fyoo zhen] noun. "The process or result of joining two or more things together to form one single entity"

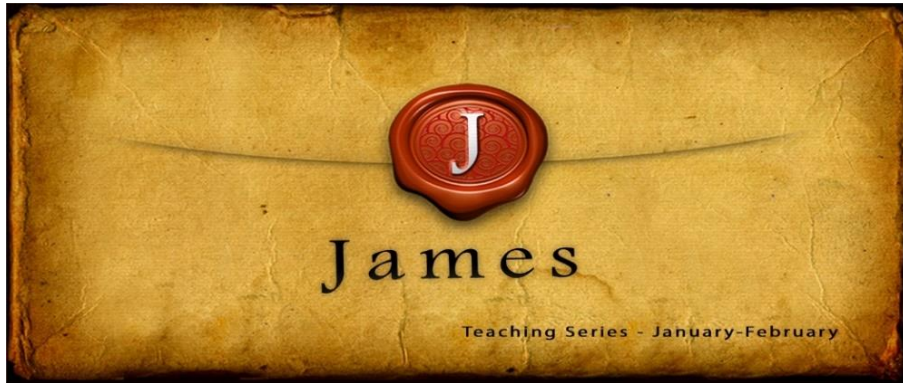
The main purpose of Fusion is to provide a Sunday morning shared experience so that families are empowered with tools that will lead to life-transforming relationships.

The book of James was written by Jesus brother James (IAKOBOS [Greek] = Jakob). James initially rejected the message of Christ, and it wasn't until later on that James believed in the resurrection and gave his life to the ministry of Christ. The book of James was written around 40-60 AD, a time where eye-witnesses of Jesus' death and resurrection still lived.

James became a leader of the church in Jerusalem after Jesus' resurrection, and led the church through times of famine and persecution. The main theme in the book of James is to answer the question: 'How are believers to live out their faith in everyday life?' This goes beyond just hearing the word of God, to obeying it as well. Join us as we journey together for this 8-week series - we will walk through the biblical themes associated with Christ-centered living.
