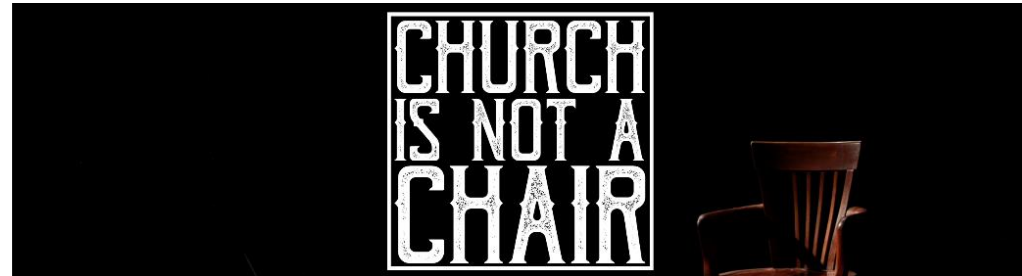

What comes to mind when you hear the word Church?
Many think of a specific style of worship, the building where people gather, or even their own specific seat in the sanctuary.

We live in a culture where events, programs and organizations serve the interests of the individual. It's no wonder that so often we treat church the same way. Like a chair: a place where we have our own seat, a place that fits our needs and expectations, a place that makes us feel comfortable, a place that exists to serve us.

The word church comes from the New Testament word *Ekklesia* which means *Gathering*. The apostles of Jesus understood 'Church' as a gathering of Christ followers not attached to any building, style of worship, or specific seats, but as a group of believers gathered around one historical event: The Resurrection.

Over the next three weeks, we will be walking through a series which seeks to reorient our thinking about this two thousand year old movement, The Church, which is still moving today. Join us as we journey together!
