What comes to mind when you hear the word Church?

Many think of a specific style of worship, the building where people gather, or even their own specific seat in the sanctuary.

We live in a culture where events, programs and organizations serve the interests of the individual. It's no wonder that so often we treat church the same way. The word church comes from the New Testament word Ekklesia which means Gathering. The apostles of Jesus understood 'Church' as a gathering of Christ followers not attached to any building, style of worship, or specific seats, but as a group of believers gathered around one historical event: The Resurrection.
