*The Gospel of John has been a favorite of many readers of the New Testament and is full of beauty, mystery, and, occasionally, surprises. It is here, that John points to a new way of living. It is the 'Kingdom of God way of life'. John's primary purpose is to lead us to Jesus, "the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world." (1:29).*

*And through this belief John promises that we would have eternal life in his name (20:30-31).*

*Join us, as we navigate our way through John's Gospel in 16 weeks, ending on Easter Sunday morning. To start, we will approach the Gospel of John in a way that looks at key themes. These themes will provide a broader understanding of what it means to be a King Jesus follower in a 'countercultural' way. Following, Jesus reveals something important about His divine nature, His character, and His mission by declaring "I am the bread of life" (6:35), "I am the light of the world" (8:12), "I am the good shepherd" (10:11), "I am the way, the truth, and the life" (14:6). Finally, John uses selected signs to reveal the majesty, the 'supremacy' of Jesus, the "Christ" of God, culminating in God's greatest sign, the Cross and Resurrection of Christ.*

*You might be wondering...what does it matter, that 'the Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us' (John 1:14). It matters because God takes the human experience seriously—so seriously that he became human to reflect the true and authentic way to be a Christ follower in our world.*
