HAPPENINGS PAGE: BAPTISM AND MEMBERSHIP



When it comes to Baptism, many talk about 'being ready' for this event as a step in their faith journey. So what does it mean to be ready? Often, 'being ready' is defined as being at a certain level of spiritual maturity in our walk with Jesus which qualifies us for baptism. If this is the case, it's actually a misleading and unbiblical way to think about baptism.

In the New Testament, Baptism and Conversion were a part of the same event, people would give their lives to following Jesus, and be baptized. In the great commission from Matthew 28:19, baptism is step 1 to becoming a disciple: "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, **baptizing** them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit..."

This morning, you'll have the opportunity to hear testimonies of some people who have given their lives to Jesus as Lord and desire to obey his first command to be baptized into the local church. As you listen to these stories, I invite you to reflect on your own story. How has Jesus been present in your life in the past? How has Jesus been at work in your life recently? What is Jesus calling you into in the future?
