Happy New Year!

I pray that your CHRISTmas Season was an amazing experience. Around here at Eastview, it was a busy but fulfilling time of year. Our Advent journey through Peace, Love, Hope and Joy was a good reflection in preparation for the manger.

My personal reflection around the manger and the birth of Jesus really moves quite quickly to why the baby had to come. I have heard in the past that some folks don't like to associate the manger with the cross – but you cannot have one without the other.

There is a song we have done recently (and we will do more of) called, "What A Beautiful Name" that helps focus on JESUS and what He came to do. The bridge (later part of the song) says,

*Death could not hold You / The veil tore before You
You silence the boast of sin and grave
The heavens are roaring / The praise of Your glory
For You are raised to life again*

*You have no rival / You have no equal
Now and forever God You reign
Yours is the kingdom / Yours is the glory
Yours is the Name above all names*

Can you imagine that on the Friday – that sin and the grave were boasting? And as He rose to life, the heavens roared giving God praise and glory? It's a really intense image. God has no rival, no equal, He reigns forever, it's His Kingdom – He is the name above all names!
