### Willowdale Community Fellowship, Tyndall MB

*-Our weekly Bible Study and Prayer time is well attended by 10-12 individuals. This represents about a third of the adults!*

*-Our monthly seniors lunch, since fall has seen an increase from 18-22 attending to a consistent average of 35...the majority are from the community and not yet a part of Willowdale. Our volunteers are great in the kitchen and serve with joy!*

*-Athletes in Action will return to Garson for the third year to run a 9-14 year old multi-sport camp in July. These have been very successful and attendance has grown each year. Working with them has been excellent and for now, it provides a program that we are unable to do and puts our "face" in the community.*

*-Last summer we did a trial run of "Willowdale Camping". A number of families met in Birds Hill Park for a weekend of family camping and activities...we held our church service in the park on Sunday morning...it was well attended and everyone loved the open sky time together*

*-Gwen and I have hosted the church on a number of occasions for our church picnic and wiener roasts. Our love for one another has grown far beyond being a Sunday Service Church...we are family and the sense of community attachment is growing.*

*-Sunday mornings just keep getting better! Our lunches are loud as the conversations around the meal are vibrant and somewhat animated. I think we are a church with a good sense of humour...laughter abounds.*

*-One of our more recent members drives from his home close to Red River College, picks up 2-3 Forward House guys, and brings them out to the Bible Study and Sunday Services every week! He had quit attending church a few years ago and I challenged him to just show up for 6 months, every Sunday and grow with us...He did and is highly involved!*

*-Since January I have been teaching two Bible classes at Forward House and will be helping Peter Harzan get a "hands on" wood working project going this spring.*

*-Our greatest growth has come in the form of answered prayer for children! Five years ago we had 4-5 children in a "kids church" program and now 13-15 march out part way through the service. This is very encouraging as we see our first youth program down the road.*

*-Recently, we had the Eastview Youth Worship band out to serve us in song...these 15-16 yr old young people were such a blessing to us! They played with skill and spiritual maturity. With only 2 of our own people to lead worship, its been a bit tough. Also, since we have started we have been in a bit of a leadership deficit...please pray for growth in both areas.*

*-Gwen and I are overall doing well and most often find ourselves invigorated by the people and exhausted in serving! Perhaps that is the best combination. Your prayers for some on going health concerns for myself would be appreciated.*
